Jake Merrick Delivers Radical Transparency in Unfiltered 45-Minute Interview

Grassroots Candidate Answers Voters' Toughest Questions as Mainstream Media Focuses on Big-Money Candidates

OKLAHOMA CITY – While big-money candidates secure lengthy interviews on major television networks, Jake Merrick—the only Republican gubernatorial contender who has pledged to refuse all PAC and special-interest funding—released a powerful 45-minute, unscripted video interview tackling the hardest questions Oklahomans are asking.

In the wide-ranging discussion, Merrick faces direct, no-holds-barred questions on property taxes and OTA reform, school choice, green energy, tribal relations and McGirt, and more—delivering candid, detailed answers with zero notes or teleprompters. Most people will be stunned by what he reveals in just the first 6 minutes.

“Voters keep telling me they’re tired of soundbites and want real answers,” said Merrick. “The heavily financed candidates get prime-time TV spots because of their millions in cash, but Oklahomans deserve transparency from every candidate. That’s why we’re putting this interview out unfiltered—so the people can judge for themselves.”

Merrick continued, “This is radical transparency in action. No question was off-limits, no answer was rehearsed. If mainstream outlets won’t give grassroots candidates equal time, we’ll go straight to the people.”
